The income from the Name of Fund shall be distributed in a manner consistent with those specified in the Foundation's governing documents as they now exist on the date hereof or as they may hereafter be amended. It is our intent that the income shall be distributed at least annually through the _______ Scholarship to provide assistance for purpose of Scholarship, as outlined in Schedule B hereof, taking into consideration the written recommendations made to the Foundation by the duly authorized Scholarship Committee.

- 4. Distributions as provided in paragraph 2 shall be consistent with the Homer Foundation's Spending Policy. However, the Foundation Trustees may, if they consider circumstances to exist which make it advisable to invade principal, authorize distributions from the principal of the Fund for the purposes as provided in 2 above.
- 5. Notwithstanding anything herein contained to the contrary, the Fund shall at all times be held and administered in accordance with the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, and Policies of the Foundation and applicable tax regulations, as they now exist or as they may be amended, all of which are hereby accepted and agreed to by the undersigned, including those provisions relating to amendment, termination and variance from the donors' directions. The undersigned acknowledges

that under the provisions of the applicable tax regulations, the Foundation Trustees have the power and the duty to modify any restrictions or condition on the distribution of funds for any specified charitable purpose if, in its sole discretion, the purpose has become, in effect, unnecessary or incapable of fulfillment or inconsistent with the charitable needs of the southern Kenai Peninsula.

Upon such acceptance, this letter will constitute our agreement with respect to the Name of Scholarship Fund and all prior discussions and agreements concerning the Fund are merged herein and are made a part hereof.
